Pastor's Reflection

With two baptisms coming up when we celebrate Pentecost on May 27, I want to share with you some helpful information which ran a few years ago in The Interpreter (a United Methodist publication).

What is the difference between infant baptism and believer's baptism?

In infant baptism God claims the child incorporation into the universal with divine grace. In believer's baptism the person being baptized is publicly professing his/her own decision to accept Christ.

Can we have our baby dedicated instead of baptized?

No. Dedication is something we pledge or give to God. United Methodists understand baptism as God's pledge and gift to us.

How about christening?

It is the same thing as baptism.

Can I be baptized again if I feel the need?

No, baptism is an act of God, and God does it right the first time.

Should every baby be baptized?

No, baptism assumes that the child

will be nurtured and formed in the faith at home and at church. If parents or guardians do not agree to nurture children's faith, baptism should be delayed until the parents are ready or until children can profess their faith.

Does baptism make me a member of the church?

Yes, baptism is an act of initiation and church of Jesus Christ, the United Methodist Church and the local congregation.

Do I have to be baptized to be saved?

No, but baptism is a gift of God's grace to be accepted as part of the journey of salvation.

This Q & A just touches the surface of the subject. I hope you will be present on May 27 when Alex Lee and Matthew Wicker receive baptism (and along with four other young people profess their faith in Christ). And remember to wear red!


