Pastor's Reflection

The Second Most Important Sunday in the Year

Throughout the Christian world, Pentecost is regarded as the second-most important Sunday in the Christian calendar. It is second only to Easter. You wouldn't know that, though, would you? Only in recent years have United Methodists and other Protestants here in the United States begun to catch the "spirit" of the annual Pentecost celebration.

Many years before Jesus' birth his people, the Jews, had a major festival fifty days following the Passover. The name "Pentecost" comes from the Latin for fifty.

The events in Jerusalem fifty days after Easter, recorded in Acts 2, constitute the heart of our Christian understanding of Pentecost. It is the day the spirit of God fell upon the disciples "as of tongues of fire." They spoke in foreign languages. Jews from foreign nations heard the good news about Jesus Christ in their own languages. Peter preached a powerful sermon, and many people were converted. They all received Baptism.

And last but not least, the Church was born.

That's some of what we will celebrate on Sunday May 19. It will be a great day for baptisms and for eight young people to affirm their faith in Christ and become Professing Members of the United Methodist Church.
