ORGAN WORK — The work on the organ is ongoing. With the work on the console at its completion, Robert Coulter is voicing (giving the pipes a new voice); it's like having a voice transplant so you can sound like Pavarotti, Nathan Gunn, Renee Fleming, etc. This is a delicate process and time consuming process and requires the work of an artisan. Most of what Robert Coulter is doing is correcting issues with pipe speech and creating a sound that complements the majesty of our place of worship, and is doing this at no cost to the church. He is concerned about the overall quality of the sound and integrity of the pipes. He reported awhile back that ranks of reed pipes (trumpets, clarinet, oboe, bassoon, due to metal corrosion — lead sugaring), were not able to be tuned. The trustees are working diligently to prevent this corrosion from causing these ranks of pipes from becoming unusable. Expect to hear more about this issue in the coming weeks. And if you have any questions, feel free to stop by my office or set up an appointment with me, and I will show you pipework that has suffered this metal sugaring. It should be noted that this white powder (called lead sugar) is toxic. — Jon Kroepel
