Former CBS anchor Dan Rather found himself unprepared for a television interview with Mother Teresa several years ago. Ron Mehl described the newsman's encounter this way:

Somehow, all of his standard approaches and formula questions were inadequate for the task, and the little nun from Calcutta, sitting beside him so sweetly and tranquilly, didn't seem inclined to make his task easier.

"When you pray," asked Rather, "What do you say to God?"

"I don't say anything," she replied, "I listen."

Rather tried another track. "Well, okay...when God speaks to you, then, what does he say?"

"He doesn't say anything. He listens."

Rather looked bewildered. For an instant, he didn't know what to say.

"And if you don't understand that," Mother Teresa added, "I can't explain it to you."

There's a great deal that we do not understand about prayer. Getting closer to God and gaining knowledge of God are possible through prayer. Being silent and still allows God time to commune with us in prayer. According to Eugene Peterson's The Message: "God's Spirit touches our spirits and confirms who we really are." I've thought about prayer and God's "touching" our spirits throughout Vacation Bible School. There was a great deal of hard work and talent provided to make the spaces we used sacred spaces of learning and fun. I am thankful for the leaders and all the volunteers (and I will not name names because someone is always accidentally left out). The purpose of prayer is to draw us closer to God. Prayer is a yielding exercise. It is not a list of things we want God to do. It is a time to talk about real struggles and circumstances that cause us to question of faith. It is a time to confess our shortcomings and to admit that being "spiritual" and "faithful" are not the same thing. We can believe in God and still hold God at arm's length. Acknowledging God is not actually "plugging into" God's power. The function of prayer is: 1. Adoration. 2. Confession. 3. Thanksgiving. 4. Supplication.

John Wesley and his friends gave us a prayer to use: Almighty God, unto Whom all hearts be open, all desires known, and from Whom no secrets are hid, Cleanse the thoughts of our hearts by the inspiration of Thy Holy Spirit, that we may perfectly love Thee, and worthily magnify Thy holy Name; through Christ our Lord. AMEN.

I pray that we can come to understand more and more about the faith and in so doing honor the Lord. It is particularly appropriate as we enter July and celebrate our birth as a nation. There are churches that will miss this chance to celebrate because there is the idea "out there" that Christians are not supposed to do anything patriotic in worship. We are to do nothing that celebrates our nation! I am not of that persuasion, so we will. The first Sunday in July we will sing some patriotic hymns during the Second Hymn portion of worship. We do this because we love our country. Yet, our home is heaven. We are citizens of two worlds. Our nation teaches us to love kindred and country. Our faith teaches us to honor God and exhibit faith. WE can do both. And while we celebrate America we can also pray for America. Pray that we be: "one nation under God..."


