**INFORMATION ABOUT CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) AND THE UNITED METHODIST CHURCH:** To view South Carolina United Methodist Bishop L. Jonathan Holston's statements of recommendation for dealing with the COVID19 pandemic in local churches, please go to <u>www.umcsc.org</u>. On that same website, you will find multiple resources to answer many of your "who, what, when and where" questions for all things related to the COVID19 pandemic and how it's affecting local church activities/business. Please note: The SCUMC Conference website is constantly being updated with new information so you may want to check it out frequently.

CHURCH OFFICE OPERATIONS: As you know, both the Worship and Administrative ministries of your FUMC have been following the guidelines recommended by SCUMC Bishop L. Jonathan Holston as posted on his March 12 and March 17, 2020 Conference Website messages (see umcsc.org). Per the 3/12/20 message, Bishop Holston recommended that all church offices stay open during their regularly scheduled office hours, following the lead of state and local governments. On Wednesday, March 25, 2020, all Chesterfield County offices closed their facilities to the public beginning at 5PM. Consequently, as recommended by the Bishop and in response to the County offices closing, FUMC will make some minor adjustments to our regular office hour schedule. Beginning Tuesday, March 31st, Admin. Assistant Angie Smith will be working from home, answering phones through our remote call system per her regularly scheduled office hours of Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays, 8:30AM-4:30PM, with an hour closed for lunch of Noon-1PM. Please take note that because this Remote Rollover Call System involves only one line of availability, all calls need to be limited to five minutes or less so that other calls will be able to be answered promptly. Angle will also be regularly monitoring the FUMC Facebook page. Secondly, so that our church building will still be accessible to our FUMC members and the Cheraw community, Pastor Kim will be available at the church office per the following schedule - Tuesdays, 2pm-5pm; Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Fridays, 10am-Noon and 1PM-5PM. This on-site schedule will accommodate the 21 hours per week that the church office is typically open. Please note that when you come to the church door and ring the bell, there may be a slight wait if Pastor Kim is on the phone and unable to answer the door immediately. Also, please remember that if you don't see Pastor Kim's vehicle in the parking lot, don't assume that she is not at the church. With warmer weather approaching, she may be taking advantage of the brief jaunt, by foot, from parsonage to church. And one final note, the church answering machine will be checked every day first thing in the morning, as well as the last task of the day, so feel free to leave a voicemail at any time and you will receive a return call...

**ONE CALL COMMUNICATIONS:** First UMC is using our One Call communication system quite frequently during this time of restriction and separation caused by the COVID19 pandemic. This One Call system involves a recorded message from First UMC which comes to your selected phone number automatically, with the latest news and notifications. And the service is absolutely free! Just call or email the church office with your preferred phone number and Angie will import you into our system. In this time of forced social distancing, let's make sure to NOT simultaneously practice emotional distance!

**SPRING BBQ CANCELLED:** In light of the 3/17/20 speech by Governor McMaster, along with the Town of Cheraw's decision to cancel the Spring Festival, along with South Carolina United Methodist Bishop Holston's recommendations for local churches, along with President Trump's guidelines on social distancing, the First UMC United Methodist Men have decided to cancel the Spring BBQ. You are encouraged to take the following steps for refund of advanced ticket sales: all ticket sellers are invited to get in touch with your ticket buyers, and offer them a full refund in return for their ticket; upon return of the tickets to the church office, ticket sellers will be refunded the full price of their returned tickets. We thank all of our church family who have supported the Spring BBQ in the past, and we invite you to continue to find other ways to support our scouting programs and other ministries typically funded by the Spring BBQ proceeds. The First UMC United Methodist Men regret this unusual cancellation, but we pray that our First UMC family will graciously understand this decision.

**RELAY FOR LIFE ACTIVITES**: For the safety of our staff and volunteers, the American Cancer Society, Southeast Region (Charlotte) has closed their offices to the public until further notice. All events including the Relay for Life of Chesterfield County and in-person meetings have been suspended through mid-May.

**HOLY WEEK AND EASTER ACTIVITIES:** Quite obviously, due to the COVID19 pandemic, some of our Holy Week and Easter activities will need to be adjusted. But please be assured that your FUMC staff and Committee volunteers are working diligently to present as "close to normal" worship experiences as possible! So mark your calendars now! Using similar e-resources as we've been using over the past two weeks, we HOPE to bring you a festive Palm Sunday worship celebration! Likewise, as we move into Holy Week, please look for more information on special e-services for Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunrise, and Easter Sunday! In offering a few "teasers" of our upcoming plans: please make sure you have some supplies ready by Holy Thursday, to participate in an "in-home Lord's Supper celebration", and, be prepared to purchase some fresh flowers to be added to our Easter Celebration Cross which will be displayed on our front church steps on Easter Sunday morning!
