The One Call system is absolutely free, so we invite you to take advantage of this wonderful opportunity to STAY INFORMED.

**CHURCH EMAIL CORRESPONDENCE:** Yet another opportunity to stay informed which your FUMC staff offers, is our church email correspondence. Congregational emails are a perfect way to "get the word out" to our entire faith family about upcoming activities, important announcements, as well as the "happenings" of our various church committees. If your email address is not yet registered with FUMC, please call or email Angie at the church office and let her know how we can continue to keep you informed through our church email announcements.

**FOR EVERYONE'S SAFETY:** As we begin re-entry into our church facility and re-start some of our church activities and meetings, please be sure to be a good steward about our church alarm system. This is an increased time of stress for our community, and thus, it is vital that we practice SAFE OPERATIONS at all times to protect our church staff and our church leaders.
