Our 2021 Lenten Journey Begins February 17, 2021

Rend your heart, and not your garments; return to the LORD your God, for he is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness; and He relents from doing harm.

Joel 2:13 New King James Version

# Virtual Worship




#### Your Help Needed!
