

A Few Words from the Pastor...

Let them praise his name with dancing, making melody to him with tambourine and lyre! Psalm 149:3

The chorus of the song, *I Hope You Dance*, concludes with the words, "when you get the choice chance to sit it out or dance, I hope you dance." Often in life circumstances set us back and we do not feel much like dancing. The pandemic we are still living through certainly creates fear, shock, and loss for us and for people all over the world. Close dancing was snuffed out by necessary social distancing and dance parties are just not a wise choice with the risk of spreading the virus.

Even so, hope of new life is all around us. Spring is here. People are getting vaccinated and the case count in our county is down. Jesus is risen! Those are all reasons to dance. The first dance step is to acknowledge our loss but not be restricted by it. The next step is to accept the challenge to find new ways to dance. In Psalm 149:3 we are encouraged to praise God with dancing, tambourine, and lyre. We can make melodies that praise God by moving our limbs, tapping a rhythm instrument, and strumming a string instrument. This Psalm 149 dance requires changes in our usual dance moves.

The disciples had trouble changing their dance moves too. When Jesus appeared to Mary Magdalene, the women, and the two disciples on the Emmaus Road they were still dancing a funeral dance. Their sorrow and pain still had to be worked through before they could accept the new resurrection dance Jesus came to teach them. Jesus knew that and helped them so they could dare to dance a new dance.

Jesus is walking with us as we travel through the changes in how we do life together as the church. It is requiring us to let go of some things so that we can learn a new dance. As we move into a new normal together, let us dare to dance again! Let us meet Jesus on the dance floor and allow him to teach us some new dance moves.
