A Few Words from the Pastor...

But prove yourselves doers of the word [actively and continually obeying God's precepts], and not merely listeners [who hear the word but fail to internalize its meaning], deluding yourselves [by unsound reasoning contrary to the truth]. James 1:22 AMPV

Last week we began a sermon series on the letter from James to the churches dispersed throughout Asia-Minor. The series will continue through September as we focus on being doers of God's word and not just listeners of God's word.

One of the greatest challenges of our Christian Journey can be discerning how we live out our faith in the world. Martin Luther and John Wesley had discussions about this pesky letter from James. The issue for Luther was that we are saved by faith and not by works. John Wesley agreed but also insisted, as the Apostle James does, that true faith is alive with good works.

It is absolute truth that we are saved by grace through faith. We cannot earn our way to eternal life by the good works we do. Salvation is by faith in our Lord Jesus, period! However, that does not mean that we are off the hook about good works.

Good works are a response of our gratitude to God for our salvation. We are doers of the word because we want to let God and the world around us know how grateful we are for the gift of salvation that we have freely received. Jesus explains the purpose of our good works in Matthew 5:16, "let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven." James encourages us to do this too.

James explains that we accomplish this by how we act in our daily interactions with each other and by acts of mercy towards others. He urges us to exercise self-control with anger, pridefulness, speech, and spending. Then, with pure hearts we are to do good works to care for the downtrodden, the poor, and to help widows, and orphans.

I look forward to continuing our journey together with the book of James. May we always listen carefully and then be doers of God's word together here at FUMC.
