A Few Words from Pastor Debra...

The disciples saw Jesus do many other miraculous signs in addition to the ones recorded in this book. But these are written so that you may continue to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing in him you will have life by the power of his name. John 20:30-31 NLT

Epiphany and the season after it shine a revealing light on who Jesus is. It tells us why Jesus, the incarnated living Son of God, makes a difference in our lives. It also reveals how we as Jesus' disciples, are to respond to these revelations. Epiphany Sunday revealed Jesus as the Light of the World who came to eliminate the darkness of sin and death. Our response is to be living lights that reflect the love, mercy, and grace of Jesus into the darkness of the world around us.

The first Sunday after the Epiphany revealed that Jesus was with God when we were created and formed and named and claimed by God. We are to respond this revelation with lives of fearless faith because we are part of God's family. The third Sunday revealed to us that Jesus has the power to do miraculous things. We are to respond by seeing the glory of God's Son and believe in him. On a lighter note, several years ago a young Sunday School student of mine summed up the miracle of changing water into wine. He said, "if you're going to a wedding make sure Jesus shows up too!" Amen!

In John's gospel, Jesus does show up in what John refers to as miraculous signs. They are signs of Jesus glory and power. The purpose of the miraculous signs John tells us is so that we will believe in Jesus and have life and power in his name. The first miraculous sign of Jesus was to turn water into wine at a friend's wedding in Cana.

This sign reveals Jesus as much more that a miracle worker. The glory of the Lord shines forth astonishing wedding guests, bringing praise to the bridegroom and his family, and convinces the disciples to believe in Jesus' power. Jesus listened to his mother, showed compassion for the wedding party and their guests, and literally saved the event from a major hospitality faus pax that would have brought dishonor and shame to the wedding hosts.

Yet, this miraculous sign reveals even more to us. It shows that Jesus has the power to make amazing changes. Not only can this miraculous winemaker change water, he can also save us and change us from sinners into his disciples. Jesus can change a dying church into a living vibrant one. Jesus can resurrect a life that was headed for death in the throes of addiction. Jesus can heal broken marriages and broken lives. Jesus can and does perform miracles today. I know this is true because I have seen many miraculous signs in my life.

The response we are called to have sounds simple but can be incredibly hard. We are to believe in Jesus! When the storms of life are raging, we are to believe in Jesus. When hate, evil and injustice seem to be winning we are to believe in Jesus. When anything tries to steal our joy we are to believe in Jesus. No matter what happens we are to believe in Jesus. Emmanuel, God with us, the Son of God, our Lord Jesus will show up with miraculous signs and walk us through to the other side. Believe it!
