

LIGHTING OF THE ADVENT CANDLES³

Reader One: Isaiah said that the Lord spoke to the king and said, "Ask a sign of the LORD your God; let it be deep as Sheol or high as heaven" (Isaiah 7:11 NRSV). But when the king refused, God would not be stopped. "Therefore, the Lord himself will give you a sign. Look, the young woman is with child and shall bear a son and shall name him Immanuel" (Isaiah 7:14 NRSV).

Reader Two: God wants us to know, even when we aren't sure ourselves. God wants us to experience God's presence, even when we think we can handle life on our own. God sends us signs of God's presence with us; all we need to do is keep our eyes open and look.

Reader One: "Look, the virgin shall conceive and bear a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel," which means, 'God is with us.'" When Joseph awoke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him; he took her as his wife, but had no marital relations with her until she had borne a son; and he named him Jesus (Matthew 1:23-25 NRSV).

Reader Two: We light these candles, the candle of joyous hope, of proclaimed peace, of deep everlasting joy, and today of presence that speaks of love, as a sign that no matter our circumstance, we know we are not alone.

Light all four candles of the Advent wreath.

A few words from the pastor...

"For his anger lasts only a moment, but his favor lasts a lifetime! Weeping may last through the night, but joy comes with the morning." Psalm 30:5 NLT



Years ago, when I was battling cancer and the chemotherapy and radiation treatments brought sickness and many tears, Psalm 30:5 was a great source of encouragement for me. It was during this time that I came to understand the difference between happiness and joy. Happiness is fleeting and dependent on happy circumstances in our lives. Joy is a gift from God that flows to us through his presence among us. Joy rises above our circumstances and brings deep satisfaction to hearts and souls.

Mary and Joseph had absolutely no reason to be happy about the strange circumstances of Mary's pregnancy. The reality of this child sent from God was very stark. The dangers were real. The

potential for them to be outcasts in their community was a certainty. Yet they both believed the angelic messengers who were sent to them. Mary said yes to being Jesus's momma and Joseph said yes to being a husband to Mary and an earthly father to Jesus. Both received the gift of joy from their unborn son.

In the English Standard Version of the Bible, the words "joy," "rejoice," or "joyful" appear a total of 430 times. "Happy," or "happiness" appear only ten times.¹ Pastor Colin Smith in his Open the Bible blog says," "Christian joy flows from realizing our position in Christ: who you are in him, and what he has done for you."² As we continue our journey to the manger may we all be filled with this blessed joy! To help us along here are a few more verses about joy that I love. You can also check out Pastor Colin's blog for the twenty-one verses on joy that he shares.




