~Today's anthem, "Standing Upon This Peak of Glory," is a reflection on the Transfiguration of Jesus. The text of the anthem contains two lines of Spanish, "Pasa por aqui," meaning to "stop by here," and, "Amor Eterno," meaning, "love eternal." Larry Gosselin was inspired to write these words from the church he served in Santa Barbara, California, Saint Barbara Parish, on a Transfiguration Sunday Mass in February of 1971. "The power of the Transfiguration is revealing. Jesus was glorified in dazzling white on the mountain, but he also had a vision of what his future held in that moment – a crucifixion. Yet – Jesus, in love for us, accepted this fate unhesitatingly. Oh, the sweet, blessed Jesus who hath borne us all!"
