- ~ We welcome Reverend Phil Thrailkill into our pulpit today while Pastor Keith is out of town. Thank you for filling in! ~
- ~The organ prelude this morning is called a Fugue. Johann Sebastian Bach, one of the most prolific writers of organ music, frequently used a "Fugue" to inspire feelings of distress and angst. A Fugue is a "theme," or a certain passage of music you may hear repeated many different times throughout the course of the piece. This creates many layers of music which can sound full and busy, while also highlighting a main line of music. Bach was the creator of the original Fugue (1685-1750) and utilized its effect during the season of Lent. "The sheer season of distress and temptation must be captured by music somehow. How can we look forward to a glorious resurrection without falling down onto the nails ourselves? Heathens, we are, but Glorious is He!" J.S. Bach
