Musical Fun Fact: Our second hymn in the service, "Glorious Things of Thee Are Spoken," was removed from hymnals across the globe during World War II because of its association with Germany. The tune (AUSTRIA) became the official German national anthem and was used as a symbol for Nazi reign. Many publishers rebuked the use of this hymntune and called for a complete removal from all hymnals. The hymntune was later reintroduced to hymnody because of its beautiful melodic line coupled with stirring words, which in fact have no relation to war at all!
