**Transfiguration Sunday:** The Feast of the Transfiguration of Our Lord recalls the revelation of Christ's glory in a "dazzling light" on Mount Tabor in the presence of three of His disciples, Peter, James, and John. Christ was transfigured before their eyes, shining with divine light, and He was joined by Moses and Elijah, representing the Old Testament Law and the prophets. The Transfiguration occurred in the early months of the year (occurs on the last sunday of Epiphany and before the first Sunday of Lent) after Jesus revealed to His disciples that He would be put to death in Jerusalem and before He made His way to Jerusalem for the events of His Passion during Holy Week.
