WHAT IS MOTHER'S DAY? Mother's Day, as we know it today, originated in the US in the early 20th century. It was largely the effort of **Anna Jarvis**, who wanted to honor **her mother, Ann Reeves Jarvis**, who had been a peace activist caring for wounded soldiers on both sides of the Civil War. After Ann Jarvis died, Anna campaigned to create a day that would honor all mothers for the sacrifices they make for their children. The first official Mother's Day celebration was held in 1908 at a church in Grafton, West Virginia. Anna Jarvis chose the white carnation as the holiday's symbol. In 1914, President Woodrow Wilson signed a proclamation designating the second Sunday in May as **Mother's Day**, making it a national holiday in the US. Over time, the tradition evolved: **White carnations came to honor deceased mothers and red carnations became a way to honor living mothers.** **HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY!**
