FUMC FOOD BANK CLOSES: Following a report and recommendation on the current op-eration and challenges facing the church’s food bank, the Church Council recently, and reluc-tantly, voted to discontinue this mission of the church which had provided emergency food assistance for local residents for the past eight years. Begun in 2017 by pastor Ken Timmer-man and youth director Sara Sanderson, this effort was supported and sustained for many years through the leadership of Bonnie Cundiff and the generosity of FUMC members. Issues related to staffing, safety and the economics of scale dictated that our resources be transferred to the McArn Food Bank which is better situated to efficiently operate and administer such a program to meet the needs of our community. A basket will continue to be located outside the church office to receive food donations for transfer to McArn with weekly suggestions of needed items appearing in the Sunday bulletin.
