Over the next few weeks, we are going to try a different method. When the organ starts to play for the hymns, don’t stand immediately. The entire hymn will be played through as the introduction. Find the correct page and follow along in the hymn and stand when we reach the last line or phrase. The hope with this endeavor is that it gives you much more time to find the page of the hymn, acquaint yourself with the tune, and stand together as one body. You will need to stand with confidence! If this language is confusing to you, please watch the choir. Stand when they stand.
